Renewing Materials

You may renew most items twice, as long as there are no reserves on the item. There are three ways to renew items:

 Online using the "My Account" link at the top right corner of our website, ptlibrary.org.
Call us at (724) 941-9430 and press #1 for Library Services Desk.

3. **Visit the library** and renew items at the Library Services Desk.

If an item you want is checked out, you can place a request online through the WAGGIN catalog. When the item becomes available the Library staff will either send you an email or call you, and you will have three days to pick it up.

Library Card

You can get a card by completing an application (available in the library OR on our website) and then visiting the Library Services Desk with your driver's license or current photo ID with proof of address. You will receive your card and password to access your account online. Children through 7th grade must have a parent's signature to get a card. The parent must have a valid library card. Your card lets you borrow library materials, use the computers and the study rooms, and gain access to all of our free online resources.

Getting Books from Other Libraries

We can request materials not in the WAGGIN system through our Interlibrary Loan Service. Ask for information from the Reference Librarian on the second floor. You will be called when your materials are available for pickup at our library. The due dates are set by the lending library, so we are not able to renew Interlibrary Loan books.

Length of Checkout

Books (print or CD) music CDs, Playaways, magazines, interactive books, puppets, LeapPads, and TV Series on DVD may be borrowed for two weeks. All other DVD's may be borrowed for one week.

Five video games may be borrowed per family at any one time. One Switch game may be borrowed per family at any one time. Otherwise there is no limit to the number of materials borrowed at any time.

Any lost or damaged materials will cost the price of the material PLUS a \$1.00 processing fee. *You may not replace the item yourself.*

Computer Services

Our patron workstations, operating with Microsoft Windows, provide free access to the Internet, Microsoft Office products, several excellent research resources, printing options, and email. We also have free Wifi!

All you need to use a library computer is your valid Peters Township Public Library card. If you are under 17, a parent or guardian must complete an Internet Permisssion form before you can log onto a computer. Parents and guardians may request that children only use the computers in the Children's Department, which are equipped with filtering software.
